WHAT SUPPLIES WILL YOUR CHILD NEED FOR THIRD GRADE?

Due to budget constraints, third grade teachers are asking for help with supplies needed during the school year. This is a master list for all third grade teachers. The first week of school, your child's teacher will be sending home an additional list of supplies needed. We do want to say that we will provide all supplies for children that experience hardship in acquiring the necessary materials. We are asking for each child to have the following supplies:

1 box of crayons (18 – 24 Count)

1 dozen sharpened #2 pencils

2-3 large erasers (NOT** pencil toppers)**

3 black Sharpie fine point permanent marker (or like brand)

2 boxes of Kleenex tissue

1 homework folder with pockets

2 black Expo low odor dry erase markers

2 Red ballpoint pens

1 pack of Glue Sticks

1 pair of ear buds

2 Yellow Highlighters

Pencil Box

Post-It Notes

1 pack wide ruled binder paper

Also, it would be helpful for your child to have a sturdy backpack for his/her folders, lunches, etc. Binders are not necessary and take up room in your child's backpack/desk. It is also very helpful if all materials, including jackets and other clothing, are labeled with your child's name. We have pencil boxes for students to use, but they may bring their own if they would like.
