

Principal's Corner

You may have noticed that Mr. Larry has not been working the crossing guard area. He is currently enjoying a vacation, which has changed the flow of the morning drop off and afternoon pick up. I wanted to take this opportunity to remind everyone about a few very important safety structures we have in place to make sure everyone arrives and leaves safely each day.

- Please follow the directions on the sandwich board signs in front of school. This helps traffic move more quickly.
- Do not park in the handicapped spaces without a handicapped placard.
- Pull through the drop off lane with caution. We have many younger students that need escorted across the crosswalk from the parking lot to the gates.
- DO NOT drive down the street on the wrong side. Payton Lane now has a double yellow line to remind drivers.
- Please cross at the crosswalk areas or in front of school with a staff member.

I know that even when everyone is following all these procedures that the morning carline can still get very backed up. If the carline is running slow in the morning we will announce to the staff that there is a delay and no tardies will be issued. Thank you for helping make drop off and pick up safe for all students and families!

- Do not send your child to school if he/she is not feeling well or has tested positive for COVID. Please see the current COVID guidelines below. Call the office to report this and receive guidance. Telephone: 209-839-2380
- <u>Masks</u> Masks are optional unless you are exposed to covid or have had a recent case. Please see the guidelines below.
- <u>Free Breakfast and Lunch</u> We are offering FREE breakfast and lunch for all students. Students will place their orders with their classroom teachers daily. Breakfast will be served during morning recess, not before school. The cafeteria will not be serving food before school. Here is the <u>lunch menu</u>. Students are still allowed to bring lunches from home. No lunch deliveries please.
- <u>Dismissal</u>- Thank you to all the families that have been following the drive through procedures. Following the directional arrows really helps keeps the cars moving.
 <u>Please do not pull through the parking area to drop off your student.</u> This causes a traffic flow issue when cars are pulling out of the drive through line.
 - Monday is a regular day. Please be sure to pick up your student on time.
 - TK-3 dismissed at 2:00
 - 4-8 dismissed at 3:00
 - Wednesday is a minimum day and all students are dismissed at 1:30
 - If you have to change the dismissal location for your child please contact the teacher so we can be sure your child is in the correct location after school.

I want to thank everyone for their patience with the morning drop off. Mr. Larry is on vacation, so our carline is taking much longer in the morning. If the carline is still long at 8:15 we are notifying teachers to not mark students tardy.
