#### Principal's Corner

Pizza with the Principal is one of our incentives for our Positive Behavior Interventions and Support or PBIS program. Students earn Husky Bucks by demonstrating our BARK character traits and can use those bucks to purchase items from our Husky Bucks store. Shown above are my friends from Mrs. Shook's kindergarten class. Thank you for a lovely fine dining experience and excellent lunchtime conversation!

I wanted to share a few comments on behavior trends we are seeing. Over the past several weeks, we have seen an increase in discipline for teasing and unkind words. While typically, we see some increase this time of year leading up to Spring Break, the increase this year has been alarming. One of the more disturbing trends is the increase in racial and biggotted slur words. We are even seeing the behavior in student who typically do not have disciplinary offenses and in students as young as 8. Students are using these terms in very casual ways with each other. These are beyond teasing and name calling and are considered hate speech and disciplined accordingly. I hope you agree that terms such as these have no place on our campus. I am asking students and parents to please join me this week in eradicating these terms from our school. Please have a conversation with your child about the inappropriateness of these types of words. We are a diverse community and I hope we can come together on this issue to ensure our kids are able to attend school in an environment free from this type of rhetoric.

Parents: Please complete this short check each morning and if you answer "yes" to any of the questions keep your student home and report the absence to the school office.

#### **SECTION 1: Symptoms**

If your child has any of the following symptoms, that indicates a possible illness that may decrease the student's ability to learn and also put them at risk for spreading illness to others. Please check your child for these symptoms:

Yes	No	Temperature 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
Yes	No	Sore throat
Yes	No	New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/ asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
Yes	No	Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
Yes	No	New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

#### SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure

Yes	No	Within the past 14 days, have you had close contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes in a 24 hour period) with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
