

Graduation Event Attire Guidelines

There are many events for our 8th graders in our upcoming graduation season. Here are some guidelines to help you plan for what to wear to each event.

Best Dressed Attire is appropriate for the following events:

HONOR'S NIGHT GRADUATION CEREMONY and GRADUATION DANCE

Best Dressed Attire:

- No shorts/jeans
 - No strapless, halter, one-shoulder or backless dresses – spaghetti straps are ok, should be wide enough to cover undergarment
 - Dress length must follow dress code using fingertips as a general guideline
 - Dress shoes (low heels – 1-2", flats or sandals with straps) – no flip flops
 - Dress pants, slacks or suits
 - Dress shirts, polos, neckties
- **Remember, students will be in a gown on graduation night and only their collar area and lower legs will be visible.****

PORTFOLIO COLLOQUIUM

Business Casual Attire:

- Modest, business casual attire – not too fancy
- Straps of sleeveless dresses must be equal to or greater than 4 of the student's fingers
- Dresses or skirts - length must follow dress code using fingertips as a general guideline
- Dress shoes/casual shoes (low heels – 1-2", flats, loafers, clean sneakers, or sandals with straps) – no flip flops
- Dress pants, slacks
- Buttoned shirts or polo shirts
- Nice shorts/golf shorts
