Math practice will be given nightly. All work should be done ONLY by the student.

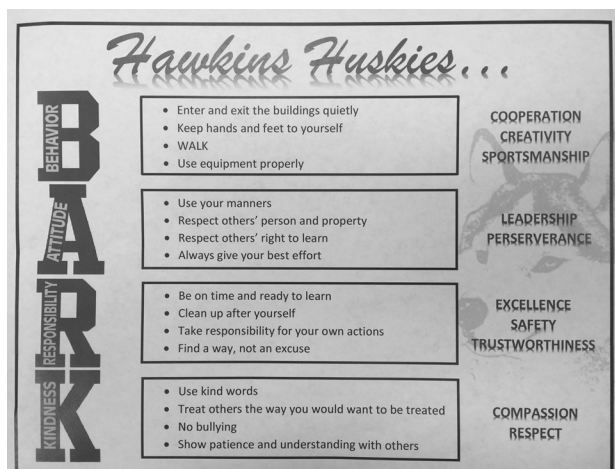
Reading nightly is expected (20 min/night).

5TH GRADE BINDER

To help your child be successful in fifth grade, students will organize ALL papers, tests, assignments, planner, etc. in their binder. Do not remove any papers! We will clean it out in class at the end of each trimester.

TEST RE-DO POLICY

ANY test or assignment may be retaken for a better grade at teacher discretion. A redo form must be filled out and turned in prior to retaking a test or assignment.

GRADING

Major (Summative) – 60%	Minor (Formative) – 40%
Summative assessment of the mastery of standards. Includes assignments such as: chapter and unit tests, major presentations, major labs, portfolios, final draft of writing assignments, inquiry projects, and major performances. Basically any FINAL project at the end of the unit that shows your “arrival” at learning.	Formative assessment of mastery standards such as quizzes, journal entries, minor labs, interactive notebook/classwork, exit slips, small group conversations, homework and quick writes. Basically the “journey” along the way to learning a certain skill or piece of knowledge.

Grades are weighted based on the following percentages. All subjects will follow this model.
