

DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING FOR ALL PERSONS SUBJECT TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

The federal Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991 requires that all persons subject to commercial driver's license requirements be tested for alcohol, marijuana, cocaine, amphetamines, opiates (including heroin) and phencyclidine (PCP).

The Superintendent or designee shall implement this program.
