## GRADUATION STANDARDS

The Board of Trustees shall confer a diploma on students who meet either of the following requirements:

1. The student has earned a 2.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 grade scale in all subjects (including electives) for their $6^{\text {th }}, 7$ th and 8 th grade years. When a student received an "incomplete" on a report card due to absences, he/she has three weeks after the end of the trimester to complete the grade(s).
2. a. The student has successfully completed his/her Individualized Educational Plan (Special Education), Individual Language Plan (English Learner Program), or a general education 504 Plan.
b. The student has passed the approved differential standards described in the Individualized Educational Plan, Individual Language Plan, or 504 Plan.

Students who have not earned a 2.0 cumulative grade point average or have not successfully completed their Individualized Educational Plan, Individual Language Plan, or 504 Plan for their $6^{\text {th }}$, 7 th and 8th grade years combined will not receive a Jefferson School District Diploma; participate in the annual graduation activities and ceremony.
