GRADUATION STANDARDS

The Board of Trustees shall confer a diploma on students who meet either of the following requirements:

1. The student has earned a 2.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 grade scale in all subjects (including electives) for their 6^{th} , 7th and 8th grade years. When a student received an "incomplete" on a report card due to absences, he/she has three weeks after the end of the trimester to complete the grade(s).

- 2. a. The student has successfully completed his/her Individualized Educational Plan (Special Education), Individual Language Plan (English Learner Program), or a general education 504 Plan.
 - b. The student has passed the approved differential standards described in the Individualized Educational Plan, Individual Language Plan, or 504 Plan.

Students who have not earned a 2.0 cumulative grade point average or have not successfully completed their Individualized Educational Plan, Individual Language Plan, or 504 Plan for their 6th, 7th and 8th grade years combined will not receive a Jefferson School District Diploma; participate in the annual graduation activities and ceremony.
