

GRADUATION CEREMONIES AND ACTIVITIES

Nonschool Awards

An agency, parent/guardian, or community member desiring to present a trophy, prize, or other awards must contact and submit a proposal to the Superintendent or designee prior to taking any steps towards publicizing or granting any awards. The Superintendent or designee has final authority as to the approval or disapproval of the proposal.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian

The principal will review all 6th, 7th and 8th grade students' report cards and determine which student(s) has accumulated the highest grade point average in all subjects and select that student as class valedictorian.

The salutatorian award will be granted to the student(s) with the second highest grade point average.

Determination of valedictorian and salutatorian will be based on three trimesters of 6th, 7th grade and two trimesters of 8th grade reporting periods.
