

Good evening Traina families,

Excitement and a smidge of sadness creeps in on me as we wind down the school year and plan our end of the year activities. This is a year I will never forget, and I am guessing that is the same for you. I look forward to celebrating the completion of this year with you and remind everyone to stay diligent in maintaining our protocols until the end of the year.

- **8th grade families:** As we enter the last couple of weeks of school, and with the ceremonies approaching on May 26th, we want to remind students to make informed decisions, so they are not required to quarantine and potentially miss their special event.
 - It is important to remember that COVID positive cases or exposures in the classroom require a 10-day quarantine.
 - We are asking you as parents to please remind your students to be mindful of any potential COVID exposures outside of the school environment. Right now, it's more critical than ever that individuals wear their masks, keep their distance, wash their hands, and avoid large gatherings with people outside of their immediate household. This is important so that it doesn't cause students or classes to be quarantined.
 - We appreciate your understanding as we work together to ensure our graduating 8th graders can participate in their activities.
 - Gown pick-ups will occur on May 20th for distance learning students between 1:15-3:15 in the gym. Please do not iron the gowns. Some suggestions for how to get the wrinkles out before graduation include a gentle cycle wash and low heat dry, or using a steamer, or taking it a dry cleaner.
- **Textbook return procedures:** We will be collecting textbooks on May 20 and 21. In-person students will return their books during class on May 20. K-3 distance learning students return their textbooks to the library between 8:15-11:15 a.m. on May 20 and May 21. 4-8th Distance learning kids return their books between 12:30-3 on May 20 and May 21.
- **Chromebook return procedures:** Chromebooks will be collected from in-person students in the classroom at the start of the final day of the school year. Distance learning Chromebooks can be dropped off via a drive-through drop them off between 1-3 p.m.
- **Tiger store pick-ups:** If your child is distance learning and made an order for the Tiger Store please come pick the order by May 21.
- **Pictures and Proofs:** We still have a lot of school pictures and proofs here in the office. Please come down to the office between 7:30-4 p.m. to pick up your child's pictures.
- **In-person students:** This is a reminder to families of in-person students. All water fountains on campus are closed, so please send water with your students as needed in a personal water bottle.
- **Intent to return:** Parents who have **NOT** yet responded to our school district's intent-to-return survey, please complete the survey **as soon as possible** so that we may plan for the 2021/2022 school year.
