Dear Jefferson School District Families,

Teachers are busy preparing for Phase Two of our Distance Learning Plan, with lessons to begin on Monday, April 6th. A list of online training resources was sent out on March 27th. This is additional information to help prepare your family for Distance Learning at home.

Grading information

During these uncertain times, students have varying amounts of resources and responsibilities. It will be important to be flexible in grading. Students with IEPs and 504s will be provided their accommodations and even more flexibility. In all grade levels, teachers will use participation, submitted work, and formative assessments to provide students with a pass/fail grade for all subjects taught. Fourth through Eighth grade teachers will continue to track assignments in Aeries as a pass/fail grade. If a student is regularly not participating, the teacher will make an attempt to reach out to the student and parent/guardian to find out if there are barriers to participating. If not, the site administration will be notified and someone from the school office will reach out to the parents/guardians.

Update on Access to Technology

Students will need a device and internet access to participate in lessons. Your home computer, laptop, cell phone, and tablets are all acceptable devices. If your family does not have a device, Chromebooks will be available for check out, only as needed, on April 3, 2020 from 8:00 am until noon. Please complete this survey by Thursday, April 2nd by noon, so we can best support your family's technology needs. If you do not have a computer or Internet access to complete the survey, please call 209-836-3388 and a secretary will complete the survey for you.


