Some common non-perishable items include:

- Dried Goods: soup mixtures, pancake mix, tea bags, powdered milk, grains
- Potato chips

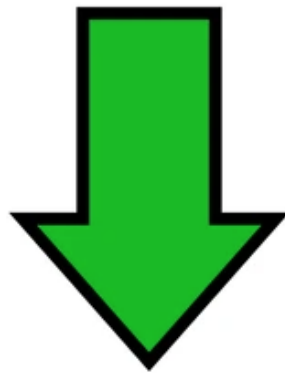
