

Where To Check-in Upon Arrival

Check-in will be in the Tracy High School Main Gym foyer. The Gym is located at the rear of the school.

Where to Park

Parking is available in front of the school. Please only park in designated spaces.

Clothing

We require that each participant have court shoes and recommended to be in a T-shirt and shorts, kneepads are optional. NO JEWELRY PLEASE.

Water and Pre-Camp Meals

All participants should have a supply of water. Participants should keep themselves well hydrated during the camp.

There will be breaks given during each session to allow campers time. We recommend that campers eat a healthy lunch prior to arriving at camp and bring a snack since the camp is over the dinner hour.

Cost

The Tracy High School Volleyball Camp will include the following: Four days of camp including Basic Skill instruction, Serving, Team Offense, Team Defense, Transition Instruction, and a Camp T-shirt. The cost of the Camp will be \$80. No Refunds will be given after June 24. There will be a \$25 administrative fee for ALL cancellations.


