Jefferson School District Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) -OLSAT Testing 2021-2022

- Fall GATE Testing 5th 8th Grade: Week of November 5th
 3rd and 4th Grade Testing: In class in December
 Spring GATE Testing 5th 7th Grade (and new 3rd & 4th grade students who miss in class testing): Week of February 7th
- 2nd Grade Testing: In class in April

There are three ways to qualify for GATE in Jefferson Elementary School District: Earn a qualifying score on the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test (OLSAT), meet the district CAASPP Score criteria, or through the teacher recommendation / portfolio process. Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) testing is open to second through eighth graders who have not taken the OLSAT 8 in the past three years.

JSD provides 2nd – 8th grade students the opportunity to participate in an assessment used for identifying Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) students. The test used is the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test, Eighth Edition (OLSAT-8) and it is administered two times each school year: Fall and Spring. The district also tests all second grade students in April, to be considered for GATE. This is part of a District-wide plan to address the disproportionate number of underrepresented student populations identified as gifted and capture students who may be overlooked using the past practice. The assessment was not offered in 2019-20 and 2020-21, so this school year we will also test all 3rd and 4th graders in December. School sites will notify parents as we move through the year and the different testing opportunities are made available.

Now is the time to request FALL GATE Testing: Parents are responsible for student transportation if participating in the after school test. If you would like your child to participate in the upcoming GATE testing, please contact the school office and ask for a GATE application or go to the Jefferson School District Website (www.jeffersonschooldistrict.com) for the application.

The application must be completed and returned to the school office by: Wednesday, November 3, 2021. Families who submit applications will be provided additional information after this deadline.

Attendance

If a student misses 2 days of school per month, they are missing over 10% of their school year!

The importance of daily school attendance must start at home, stressing the value of a consistent educational experience. It is vital for the Jefferson School District to build on this value, maintaining an essential partnership between school and home, to ensure punctual daily school attendance is a priority. Absent work completed at home is not a sufficient substitute for the quality instructions received while present in class.

Should your child need to be absent, California Education Code allows <u>EXCUSED</u> absences for the following reasons:

- Illness
- Medical/Dental Appointment
- Quarantine
- Funeral of Family Member
- To spend time with student's immediate family member who is an active duty member of the uniformed services.
- Participation in religious exercise

Please call the school at 209-833-9300 if your child is absent for ANY REASON.


The parent/guardian of the student must phone or send a note to clear any of these excused absences. The answering machine is activated after school hours for your convenience, and is checked at the start of the next school day. Failure to excuse your students' absence will result in a recorded truancy on the student's permanent record.

Being absent for any of the following reasons will result in an UNEXCUSED absence:

- Personal Days
- Going shopping
- Visiting Relatives
- Student's Birthday
- Oversleeping
- Childcare by the student at home

- Car Trouble
- Vacation
- Family moving from one home to another
- Cutting school


Education Code 4820: Students shall be classified as truant if absent from school without a valid excuse three full days in one school year, or tardy or absent for more than any 30-minute period during the school day without a valid excuse on three occasions in one school year, or any combination thereof. Such students shall be reported to the Superintendent or designee. (Education Code 48260)
