

## Why Support The Carnival?

The Monticello & Jefferson Annual Carnival is our biggest fundraiser of the year. All proceeds from the Carnival directly benefit and support your child's education. <u>Our October 2017 Carnival raised a net of \$29,701.</u> Of that, \$5,320 in teacher basket money proceeds went directly back to our teachers in early November to be used for classroom needs. The MJFPA then worked together with Monticello and Jefferson schools to find out how we could use the rest of these funds to support the education of our students, which is our primary goal. We granted "Wish List" items requested by teachers and staff, which helped pay for educational programs, field trips, supplies, equipment, books, and much more. In February of 2018 alone, the MJPFA donated a total of \$12,541 to Monticello and Jefferson schools in "Wish List" items. The remaining \$11,840 of carnival funds were donated during the rest of 2018 as listed below.

#### February 2018

**Monticello received \$5,315** for field trip funding, library supplies, books, physical fitness curriculum, student incentives and classroom supplies among other "wish list" items for classroom use.

**Jefferson received \$7,226** in school enhancements, STEAM kits, science materials, physical education equipment, library supplies, student incentives and other "wish list" items requested by teachers and staff.

### March -May 2018

**Jefferson received an additional \$6,000** for 6<sup>th</sup> grade science camp, **Monticello received another \$1,739** for Scholastic subscriptions, and the remaining of carnival funds were granted through requisitions from both schools for other field trips and teacher requests.

This is only possible with sponsors, donations to your classroom baskets, and volunteers who help make the carnival a great success. We hope that with your support, we are able to continue this for our kids.


