Kids Health is a wonderful resource for parents, kids, and teens (https://kidshealth.org/en/parents/school-help-middle.html). Kids Health suggests ten ways to keep your child on track for academic success in middle school: attend parent meetings, visit the school and its website, support homework expectations, send your child to school ready to learn, instill organization skills, teach study skills, know the disciplinary and bullying policies, get involved, take attendance seriously, and take time to talk about school. Jefferson staff is specifically working on teaching our students study skills to take with them to high school and beyond. This site gave specific suggestions that are beneficial for teachers, parents and students. They suggested to: know when tests are scheduled and plan enough study time before each one, remind your child to take notes in class and then review them at home each day, practice often to help the brain process and use the information more effectively, complete practice problems before a test in mathematics, and have your child get a good night's sleep versus cramming the night before.
