Dear Jefferson Families,

This past week I was able to go to each classroom and talk with the students. We discussed handbook items but more importantly our Jefferson Creed. Drop Off and Pick Up went quite well, however please read the information below to ensure all cars are following our procedures.

Morning Drop Off Procedures

The morning drop off went smoothly last week. Please remember that you may also use the back drop off loop located on Chrisman Road.

Afternoon Pick Up Procedures

It is normal for traffic to be congested at the beginning of the school year, but it gets better after the first week. Please make sure you are following our procedures to ensure the safety of our children and allow for the traffic to run as smoothly as possible. We do not want students entering cars that are parked on either Chrisman Road or Linne Road. Please utilize the parking spaces in the lots and your child can use the cross walk to get to your car.

Below are some options to help streamline traffic in the front lot for afternoon pick up.

- Remind your child to leave class and immediately walk to the parking lots for pickup.
- Park in the front or back lot and your child can use the cross walk to get to your car.
- Arrive 5 – 10 minutes after dismissal. This will allow time for the lot to clear.
- If possible, utilize carpooling.

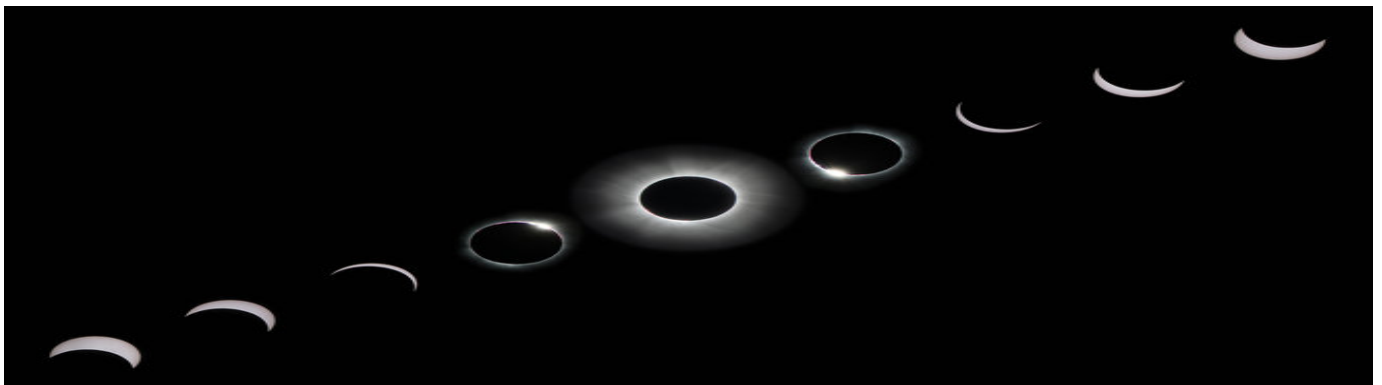

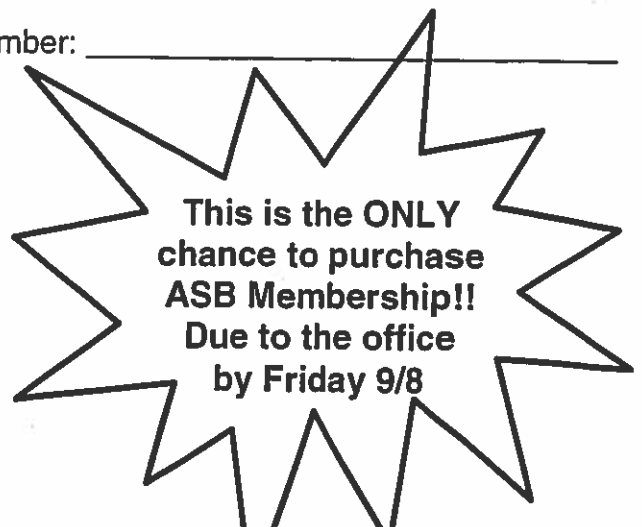

DRESS CODE

Please review the Dress Code in our Handbook on the Jefferson District Website.

Please see the graphic below for examples.

Per the district policy, the consequences for dress code violations are:

- First offense:** The student's parent/guardian shall be contacted and may be asked to meet with school staff. The student will be required to wear loaner clothes or call home for a change of clothes.
- Second offense:** The student's parent/guardian shall be contacted and may be asked to meet with school staff. The student will be required to wear loaner clothes or call home for a change of clothes. The student shall be assigned detention as determined appropriate by the principal or the designee.
- Third offense:** The student's parent/guardian shall be contacted and may be asked to meet with school staff. The student will be required to wear loaner clothes or call home for a change of clothes. The principal or the designee shall assign the student ten hours of community service to be performed within thirty calendar days.
- Fourth and subsequent offenses:** The student shall be suspended for a period of 1-5 days as determined by the principal or the designee.
