Dear Jefferson Families,

Our first full week of school was a success!! The students are ready for the upcoming school year and we can't wait to see all they will accomplish.

This past week I was able to go to each classroom and talk with the students. We discussed handbook items but more importantly our Jefferson Creed and emphasis this year on character education. We believe in our Creed: Be Responsible, Do Your Best Each Day, Think Before You Speak, Put Others First, and Avoid Conflict. Students are recognized on a daily basis for following the Jefferson Creed and are given Creed Tickets for going above and beyond. Every Monday 5 students per grade level are drawn from the raffle of tickets and earn prizes for their efforts. Furthermore, we are implementing a character education program called Second Step. Every child will engage in weekly lessons regarding skills for learning, empathy, emotional management and problem solving. Please talk with your children about Jefferson Creed and making every day count.

Thank you to all of the families that attended our Back to School Night. If you were unable to attend, please contact your child's teacher to receive the information and introduce yourself.

Drop Off and Pick Up went quite well, however please read the information below to ensure all cars are following our procedures.

Morning Drop Off Procedures

The morning drop off went smoothly this week. Please remember that you may use the back drop off loop located on Chrisman Road.

Afternoon Pick Up Procedures

It is normal for traffic to be congested at the beginning of the school year, but it gets better after the first week. Please make sure you are following our procedures to ensure the safety of our children and allow for the traffic to run as smoothly as possible. We do not want students entering cars that are parked on either Chrisman Road or Linne Road. Please utilize the parking spaces in the lots and your child can use the cross walk and to get to your car.

Below are some options to help streamline traffic in the front lot for afternoon pick up.

- Remind your child to leave class and immediately walk to the parking lots for pickup.
- Park in the front or back lot and your child can use the cross walk to get to your car.
- Arrive 5 minutes after dismissal. This will allow time for the lot to clear.
- If possible, utilize carpooling.
- Bussing is available. Please contact our Transportation Director at (209) 835-3968 if you are interested in this option or have further questions.

Nuestra primera semana completa de la escuela fue un éxito!! Los estudiantes están listos para el próximo año escolar y estamos deseando ver todo lo que van a realizar.

La semana pasada pude ir a cada aula y hablar con los estudiantes. Discutimos los artículos del manual, pero más importante, nuestro Credo de Jefferson y el énfasis este año en la educación del carácter. Dejar por la mañana procedimientos

La dejada de la mañana transcurrió sin problemas esta semana. Recuerde que puede usar el circuito de retroceso ubicado en Chrisman Road.

Procedimientos de recogida por la tarde

Es normal que el tráfico se congestione al comienzo del año escolar, pero se puede hacer mejor después de la primera semana. Por favor, asegúrese de que nuestros procedimientos para garantizar la seguridad de nuestros niños y para permitir que el tráfico se ejecute de forma tan fluida como sea posible. No queremos que los estudiantes se monten a los autos que están estacionados en la carretera o Chrisman Linne Road. Por favor, use los espacios de estacionamiento en los lotes y su niño puede usar la cruz para llegar a su coche.

A continuación se presentan algunas opciones para ayudar a agilizar el tráfico en el lote de frente al recoger por la tarde.

- Recuérdale a su hijo que al salir de clase pase inmediatamente a los estacionamientos para ser recogido.
- Parque ese en el lote de enfrente o el de atrás y su niño puede usar el cruce para llegar a tu coche.
- Llegar 5 minutos después del despido de clase. Esto dará tiempo para que el lote se desocupé.
- Si es posible, utilizar Uso compartido.
- Buses están disponible. Póngase en contacto con nuestro Director de Transporte al (209) 835-3968 si está interesado en esta opción o tiene otras preguntas.

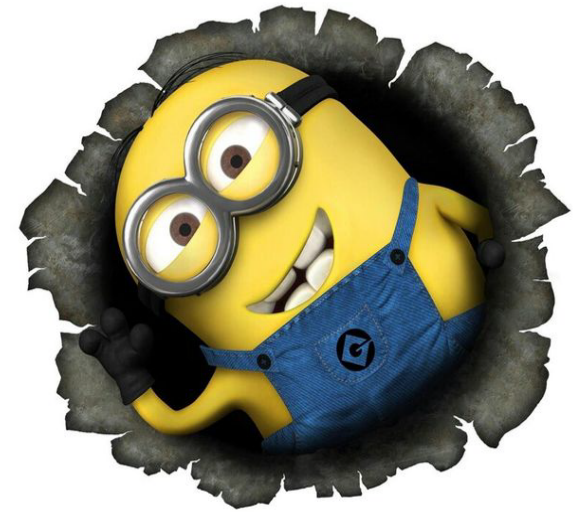
