Dear Jefferson Families,

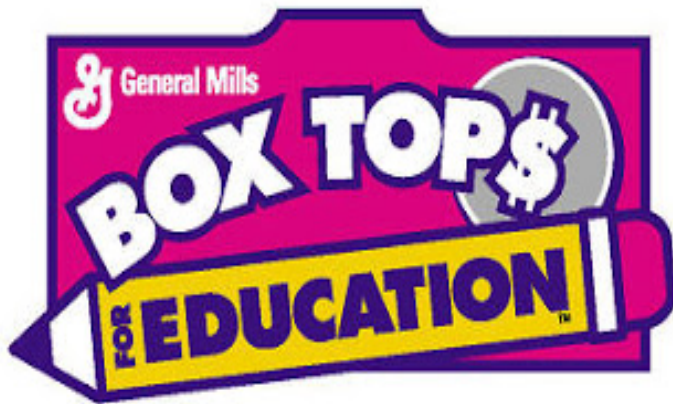
