GATE Information

In the absence of STAR testing data this year, the district is revising its qualification process for GATE students. The two possible ways to qualify for GATE for 2014-2015 will be through the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test (OLSAT) or through the teacher recommendation/portfolio process. The OLSAT test will be given to eligible 2nd-7th graders in April. Applications can be found on the district website or in your school office and are due by March 14. There will be a GATE Advisory Committee Meeting on February 19 at 3:30pm at the District Office. All GATE parents are welcome to attend.
