**Rules**

1. Posters should be 8.5" X 11" white or colored paper.
2. Media may be cut paper, pencil, ink or charcoal drawings or any suitable art materials.
3. Annual theme must be on the poster. The theme this year is *Tracy Is a No Bullying Zone I Can Help!*
4. Name of student, name of teacher, grade level of student. This should be written on the back in the lower right-hand corner.
5. Posters which do not meet all contest requirements will be not be considered.
6. All posters should be submitted to the office by 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 29, 2013 with judging happening on Wednesday, October 30, 2013.
7. Posters should not be laminated.
8. Posters MUST be the student's original work.
9. First, Second, and Third place contestants at each school will receive gift cards.

**Judging**

1. Clarity of Message  
The message should be simple and direct. "Tracy Is a No Bully Zone I can Help!"  
Points.....0 to 10
2. Artistic Merit - The art work should stimulate and spark reaction.  
Points.....0 to 5
3. Neatness  
Points.....0 to 5
