They all took a College Personality Quiz which pinpoints their interests. Please take the time to review the presentation and talk to your child about a takeaway from the assembly.

At the Career Fair, students interacted with many local businesses including veterinarians, doctors, law enforcement, agriculturists, business owners, bankers, attorneys, and more. Specifically, they asked questions such as the following:

What is the most challenging aspect of your profession?

What made you choose this career path?

Why is problem-solving so important to your career?

What classes or activities can I participate in now that would apply to your profession for my future?

Why are critical thinking and cooperative skills important for your profession?

I encourage you to talk with your child about your career, your path to success, and use the above questions as a guide for your conversation.
