Hello Jefferson Families!

I appreciate everyone's cooperation during drop-off and pick-up times in using the crosswalk at Darlene and Glenbriar and pulling to the curb before students get into and out of the car. Please remember to pull all the way up to the entrance to campus before letting your child out in the morning. This helps keep traffic flowing. Also, please remember to look behind you before pulling out into traffic. As a reminder, there is no drop-off/pick-up on Darlene. All Jefferson traffic must use Glenbriar.

Please note that the back gate closes at 7:50 each morning. If you are late, please come to the office and sign your child in to school. For afternoon pick-up, the back gate closes at 2:50 each afternoon. Any students who are still waiting for rides will be brought to the office to call home.
