

LCAP Advisory Committee – Application Jefferson School District

The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a critical part of the new Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). Each school district must engage parents, staff, and the community to establish these plans. The plans describe the school district's overall vision for students, annual goals and specific actions the district will take to achieve the vision and goals. The plans will also demonstrate how the district's budget will help achieve the goals, and assess each year how well the strategies in the plan were able to improve outcomes.

The LCAP Advisory Committee provides guidance and advice to the Board of Education and district office staff regarding Jefferson School District's progress toward meeting the goals outlined in the current LCAP and updating next year's plan.
