The new well for Jefferson School has been drilled. Output volume will be tested. If necessary, wells number two and three will be able to meet the necessary capacity for fire protection. The water storage tank is in place and will soon be painted in the same color scheme as the school. The committee discussed touring the site in early December and also discussed the open house/rededication of Jefferson School which is planned for January.

6. INPUT FOR SEPTEMBER NEWSLETTER – Items included in the May 2015 newsletter can be updated for the next newsletter. Raul Salazar suggested distributing the newsletter

annually to the community at large. Tracy Unified School District periodically includes a report of their bond projects in the City of Tracy utility bill. Staff will look into the details of this.
