**3. COMMITTEE UPDATE –** Committee member's terms have expired. Terry Thomas and Kelly DeLong agreed to renew their terms which expire June 30, 2018. Angela Hewey is an employee but will no longer be able to serve on the committee. Dr. Bridges noted that because there is remaining money available from the bond sales, the District must still have an oversite committee. The goal will be to meet once a year or twice a year at the most for the next couple of year. Ideally the Oversite Committee can meet in the Fall or Spring depending on what the bylaws say. Terry Thomas will be President, Chris Potts will serve as Vice President and Kelly DeLong will be Secretary.

**5. UPDATE ON MEASURE J PROJECTS AND TIMELINE -** Dr. Bridges noted that the only major items remaining at both sites are roof leaks in the gymnasiums. Jefferson's leaks are from the holes cut into the existing ceilings for HVAC units. Traina School's leaks are more difficult to determine but roofs of both sites are still under warranty. Acoustics are being investigated for the sites now but the bids came in close to \$40,000 which is the threshold for going out for a public bid. The sound baffling will be handled by the District's architects. Murals at both gymnasiums were completed. Jefferson had flashing beacon street signs that will blink when students are present. A shelter for the outside water pump was installed which will help the temperature fluctuations.

6. REVIEW NEW CONTRACTS OBLIGATING BOND FUNDS – The District has \$3.6 M unsold in bonds and roughly \$300K remaining from these projects. It is better that the District hold off spending funds or going out for the remaining bond money as we currently don't have any major projects for the schools. The track area at Jefferson will be reseeded on the last day of school so that students will not be at school and the field will have a chance to set up.
