Mid-Year LCAP Update	<p>Scott Andrews approved 13 of the 14 goals of the LCAP (see attached presentation)</p> <p>Goal 1: Question. Did the Solution Tree consultant visit and talk to all seasoned teachers? Response: Certain lead teachers were selected.</p> <p>Goal 2: Name of curriculum that San Ramon Valley is looking at using CKLA. Would it be possible to do a deeper dive on the current process and what we are doing for all readers.</p> <p>Goal 6: Question. Does this mean that all classes would have 2 teachers? The SPED teacher would travel along with the inclusion students. Parent noted that other schools she knows</p>

	<p>who are doing this struggle since there are disruptions. How will we support those teachers who are dealing with these hardships?</p> <p>Parent suggested idea- Can trainings be incorporated into all of the other trainings for all teachers who might see this challenge.</p> <p>Goal 7: Strong Kids program was explained, check in check out process explained. Sounds exciting, Can more details be provided?</p> <p>Goal 10: Suggested title of “community advocate” for the “social worker” role that is being developed</p> <p>Goal 12: Are smaller wish list items considered here? For example a single point of entry gate vs. multiple gates. FIT report addresses what we have, not necessarily what we want to have or what we could we have for improvement.</p> <p>Goal 14: For students with medical conditions (ie. diabetes) how will the district provide nutritional information as food moves away from ingredient labels?</p>
